

*Local Government Act 2009*

1. Gladstone Regional Council ("Council") has proposed to make each of—
  - Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019; and
  - Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019; and
  - Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019; and
  - Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019.
2. The proposed subordinate local laws amend the following existing subordinate local laws—
  - Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.1 (Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2011*; and
  - Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.15 (Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation) 2011*; and
  - Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011*.
3. Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 repeals *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.16 (Gates and Grids) 2011*.
4. *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011* authorises the making of—
  - Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019; and
  - Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019; and
  - Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019.
5. *Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011* authorises the making of Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019.
6. The purpose and general effect of the proposed subordinate local laws is as follows—
  - The purpose and general effect of Subordinate Local Law (Repealing) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 is to repeal *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.16 (Gates and Grids) 2011*.
  - The purpose and general effect of Alteration or Improvement to Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 is, to the extent that the subordinate local law prescribes criteria which must be complied with before an approval will be granted, to prescribe that an approval will not be granted if the alteration or improvement includes the installation of a gate or grid across a road, or the repair or replacement of a gate or grid installed across a road; and
  - The purpose and general effect of Carrying out Works on a Road or Interfering with a Road or its Operation (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 is, to the extent that the subordinate local law prescribes criteria which must be complied with before an approval will be granted, to prescribe that an approval will not be granted if the carrying out of the work or interference with the road or its operation includes installing a gate or grid across a road, or the repair or replacement of a gate or grid installed across a road.
  - The purpose and general effect of Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2019 is to remove the mechanism whereby a person who wishes to install, or is a responsible person for, a gate or a grid across a road may apply for an approval for a restricted activity.
7. Written submissions by any person in support of, or objecting to, the proposed subordinate local laws are invited for a 21 day period commencing on 19 October 2019 and ending on 13 November 2019 (the "consultation period").
8. During the consultation period Council will make available for inspection and purchase at Council's public office at 101 Goonoon Street, Gladstone copies of the proposed subordinate local laws.
9. Submissions must be received on or before 13 November 2019 stating—
  - the grounds of the submission; and
  - the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds.
