Queensland Symphony Orchestra's Symphony Under the Stars returns to Gladstone next month, marking the ninth consecutive year this popular musical showcase has come to town.

The Marina Parklands will host Symphony Under the Stars once again with the free event taking place from 7pm on Friday 27 August.

Based around the theme of *Around the World*, attendees will be taken on a journey to the icy beauty of Finland as Sibelius' *Finlandia* is performed, step into a bustling Bohemian village and enjoy Dvořák's *Slavonic Dances* and feel the magic of Totoro, one's of Japan's most-loved animated characters.
