CQH2 HYDROGEN FORUM

## Hydrogen - the future of renewable energy

The CQH2 Hydrogen Forum will explain why Central Queensland is the focus of the emerging hydrogen industry. While hydrogen is a relatively new industry in Australia, our presenters all have extensive knowledge on the industry and will provide detail on how the region is preparing to capitalise on this unique opportunity, what it means for Queensland and the potential projects that could materialise as the industry develops.

### **Mick de Brenni** Minister for Energy, Renewables and Hydrogen

Minsiter de Brenni's responsibilities include energy, regulation of electricity and gas sectors, biofuels, clean energy, energy industry development, hydrogen, renewable energy, building and plumbing standards, govt buildings, govt purchasing, regulation of the Qld building industry, property facilities management for govt and major projects and urban design and architecture.



### **Emma Roberts** CS Energy

Emma is CS Energy's Head of Future Energy. CS Energy is a major provider of energy in Queensland, with over 3000MW of capacity in its fleet, with a large presence in the Central Queensland region. CS Energy invested early in a pre-feasibility and feasibility study for a renewable hydrogen demonstration plant (in collaboration with IHI Japan) and will share some of the findings of those studies.



### **Leigh Kennedy** NERA

Leigh Kennedy is NERA's National Cluster Development Manager with a focus on working collaboratively with regional clusters to build an national hydrogen technology cluster for Australia that can be promoted around the world. Before joining NERA Leigh worked with Austrade's international network and govt partners to drive Austrade's global resources.



### **Alana Barlow** Sumitomo

Alana is National Hydrogen Commercialisation Manager working in the Hydrogen Department at Sumitomo Australia, focusing on development of hydrogen ecosystems, net zero society and pathways for commercialisation. Previous extensive in-house legal and in private practice experience, focusing on international trade, energy and mineral resources industries.



### **Daniel Andersen** Powerlink

Daniel brings experience across a wide range of the electricity network supply chain including network planning and investment, asset management and long term strategy development. 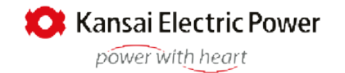
