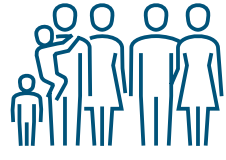
### Boyne Valley

The Boyne River, Awoonga Dam and a network of National Parks and forests combine to create a place of great natural beauty.

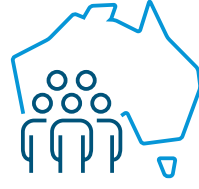
The area is home to a number of community-led events, such as the Boyne Valley Country Music Campout and The Boyne Valley Showcase.

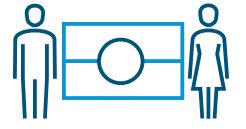

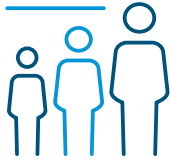
