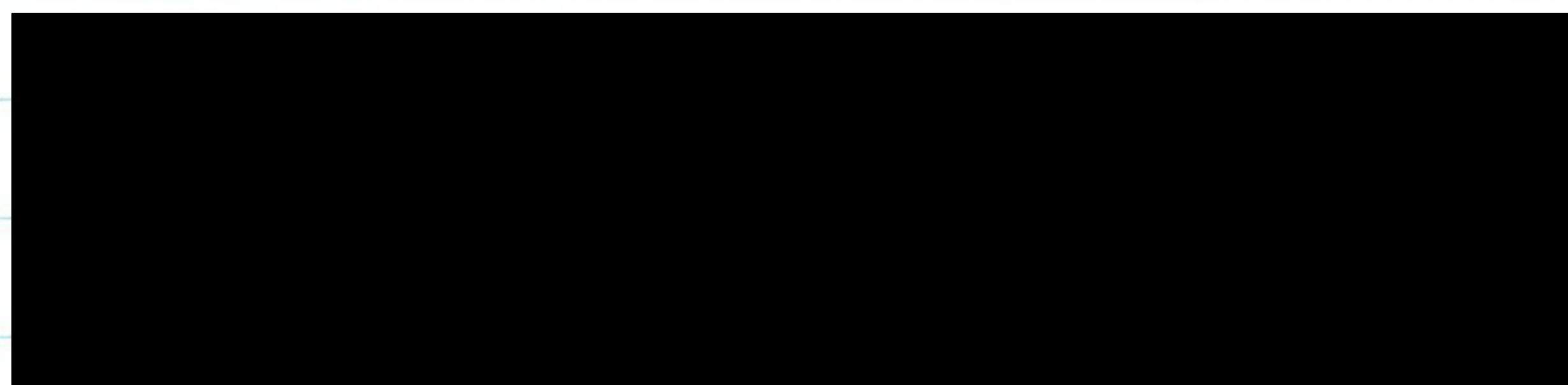
I REJECT to the NAME CHANGE of NEILS ROAD, ROSEDALE 4674

Please note we object to the name change for Neils Rd. Whilst we understand the historical reference to the family it has been spelled this way for decades.

There is too much work for us involved in changing our details with drivers licences, gun licences, vehicle registrations, phone, internet, electricity, ato, asic, super, many banks, employers, clients, many medical services, insurances,

volunteer work with RFS, my gov services, medicare, industry licences, subscriptions etc.

There is weeks of work involved with that for an L.

Sorry to the family but no from us.

It also explains why [REDACTED] saw a young man taking down the street sign a few months ago. I have already sent a request to have it replaced, reference [REDACTED] dated 1st August and 14th September. I also pointed out that currently emergency

services have no street sign which is a safety issue particularly as the fire season has erupted and I, among others, have medical issues that may require ambulances.

We hope that this issue will be resolved shortly.
