Held since 1976, the *Martin Hanson Memorial Art Awards* remain one of regional Queensland's most prestigious art awards with 272 entries submitted last year.

"Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum (GRAGM) will accept entries from 10am to 4pm between 1-4 October and from 10am until 1pm on Saturday 5 October," Councillor Burnett said.

"We continue to see an increase in entries each year drawing artists Australia wide, and I expect that trend to continue as we approach our milestone 50th anniversary.

"The Awards night itself will be held on Saturday 19 October with public voting for the QAL People's Choice Awards opening on the same day".
