

Red Landfill Bin

EVERYTHING in your **RED BIN** goes to landfill.

We must extend our landfill life by reducing waste and conserving natural resources.

- **Take stock of your fridge** and **plan ahead**.
- **Redirect food and green waste** and gain free nutrients for your plants through **composting**.
- Where possible, **buy quality goods that will last** or that are easy to repair.
- Switch to **little or no packaging - loose** as opposed to pre-packaged.
- Keep **household batteries OUT** of your **household bins**. Tape the terminals and take them to your nearest participating retailer or supermarket.

- Sanitary waste
- Broken window/glass/light bulbs (wrapped in paper for safety)
- Carbon paper
- Laminated paper
- Pet waste
- Broken pots and pans, baking tins and pyrex
- Soft plastics (any plastic that can be scrunched including cling wrap, cellophane, plastic bags and bubble wrap)
- Polystyrene/Styrofoam meat trays
- Tissues
- Paper towels
- Single use coffee cups and lids
- Single use nappies
- Broken ceramics
